

Ovehead Crane Certified Operator(OCCO)

Exam Summary Report

The Overhead Crane Certified Operator (OCCO) written exam is divided into four major knowledge dimensions. The exam contains a total of 100 items (80 scored and 20 non-scored). The non-scored items do not count for or against a candidate's exam score and are included to collect information on questions that may be incorporated into future test forms. Candidates are allotted three (3) hours to complete the exam. Table 1 outlines the number of items in each dimension.

The OCCO Exam Form 090102 was first administered in November of 2021. To date, the OCCO 090102 Exam has been administered to a total of 96 candidates of which 46 (48%) have passed (Table 2). The 090102 exam summary statistics are summarized in Table 3.

Of the 96 candidates who have taken the 090102 exam to date, the mean score was 56.22 with a standard deviation of 7.77. The raw scores ranged from a low of 29 to a high of 73. The mean p-value of 0.80 is on par with the expectations for the examination.

To earn the OCCO designation, a candidate must pass both the written and practical exams. The OCCO practical exam is coded as Form 098101. Test-level statistics for 098101 are summarized in Table 4. To date, 63 candidates have received their OCCO designation.
